Vintage : Sauternes

Location : Preignac

Size of vineyard in Sauternes : 25 hectares

Average age of vines : 30 to 40 years

Soil : the vines are planted on undulating slopes of a plateau of medium altitude on gravelly clay soil and siliceous sub-soil

Grape varieties : 70% sémillon, 28% sauvignon, 3% muscadelle

Density of plantation : 6300 vines per hectare

Vinification : vinification of each grape variety separately. Settling of the must for 10 hours. Must on the fine lees before fermentation in the fermentation vats.

Maturation : maceration in stave wood oak barrels over a period of 14 to 18 months depending upon the character of the vintage. Bottling in April-May 2 or 3 years after the vintage. Minimum of 12 months rest.
